

The Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss



BY-LAW

99-116

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Huron-Kinloss deems it necessary and in the public interest to regulate the storage and disposal of manure on Agricultural Lands;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 102, The Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1990, as amended from time to time, By-Laws may be enacted by local municipal Councils to make such regulations for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the municipality in matters not specifically provided for elsewhere in the Act;

AND WHEREAS the spreading of manure on frozen agricultural lands can have a detrimental affect to surface watercourses, which in turn can lead to pollution of lakes, streams and rivers in the Township;

AND WHEREAS the spreading of manure on frozen ground reduces the effectiveness of supplying nutrient to agricultural fields and is not a normal farm practice;

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HURON-KINLOSS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The spreading of manure on frozen ground in the Township of Huron-Kinloss is hereby prohibited.
2. This By-Law shall come into full force and effect upon its final passage.
3. This By-Law may be cited as the "Prohibit Manure Spreading on Frozen Ground By-Law"

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD TIME and FINALLY PASSED this 19th day of July, 1999.
